Through the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No. 52, dated 15.05.2015, under Section 302, 201 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Valtoha, District Tarn Taran.

At the very outset, learned State counsel submits that as only the official witnesses remain to be examined, the State would examine them at the earliest and conclude the trial within two months from today subject to the petitioner's cooperation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the bail application, at this stage, with liberty to approach this Court again for the grant of regular bail in case the State does not conclude the trial in terms of the above statement suffered by learned State counsel.
