SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J (ORAL)

The petitioner was not specifically named in the original FIR. His name transpired during the course of investigation and he was subsequently arrested on 06.06.2016. Investigation has since been completed and challan submitted against 6 persons. Some of the charge sheeted accused persons are still absconding. However, the present petitioner has remained in detention for more than one year since 06.06.2016. From the original FIR, it is clear that even if he was involved in the alleged occurrence under the category of 'unknown/unnamed' culprits, still there was no allegation of the use of any weapon by him, whether lethal or otherwise.

For the aforesaid reasons, this Court is not inclined to detain the petitioner in this fashion for an indefinite period. He is, thus, ordered to be released on bail subject to imposition of appropriate terms and conditions to be imposed by the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot.
