Learned counsel for petitioners submits that petitioners have filed this petition seeking protection of their life and liberty alleging that they are major and have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6, who are parents and brother of petitioner No. 1 and respondent No.7 who is father of petitioner No.2. Apprehending danger to their life and liberty, they moved representation dated 20.6.2017 (Annexure P-5) to Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala. Learned counsel for the petitioners has also filed a separate affidavit of Mohit-petitioner No.2 in support of the petition. He confines the relief claimed in this petition for direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

In view of the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala to look into the representation dated 20.6.2017 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of copy of this order along with representation in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
