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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing FIR No.105 dated 21.04.2016, under Sections 287/337/338/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Focal Point Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has recently sustained head injury on account of which he had to undergo operations twice on 18.04.2017 and 01.05.2017 respectively and he has been advised to take rest and is not in a position to appear before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner limited his prayer in this petition that personal appearance of the petitioner be exempted before the learned trial Court keeping in view the medical condition of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the personal appearance of petitioner before the trial Court is exempted subject to the following conditions:-

(i) petitioner shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute her identity as an accused: (iv) shall have no objection, if, the prosecution evidence is recorded in her absence, but in the presence of her counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
