A perusal of record goes to show that the petition in hand has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 5 to save the life and liberty of petitioners from respondent No.6 and other persons. Claiming the said relief in the petition, the details of the wrongful acts said to have been committed by respondent No.6 with petitioner No.1 are given.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners will be satisfied if a direction is given to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the representation submitted by petitioner No.1-Sunita Rani, copy

of which has been placed on file as Annexure P-1 and then to take suitable action in the matter.

Accordingly, the petition in hand is disposed of directing the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievances of petitioners as detailed in representation Annexure P-1 and then to take suitable action in the matter if the circumstances so want. This be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of.
