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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This petition has been filed praying for direction to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family, which is in danger at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7.

It is alleged that respondent No.6 had borrowed a sum of Rs.18,000/- from the petitioner on 15.12.2006, in lieu whereof he gave a cheque of Rs.18,000/- to the petitioner, which was dishonoured.

Respondents No.6 has been threatening the petitioner to return the cheque. On 05.04.2017, when she was going on his scooty, she was given beatings by respondent No.6, relating to which FIR No.47 dated 05.04.2017 under Sections 341, 323, 379 and 506 IPC was registered against respondent No.6. Despite that FIR, no action has been taken against respondent No.6, who is openly threatening the petitioner with active aid of respondents No.4 and 5. In this regard, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 03.06.2017 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.3 but no action thereon has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take a decision on the representation dated 03.06.2017 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-2) and take necessary action as may be warranted in law.
