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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner is a poor unmarried girl and belongs to Scheduled Caste. She was awarded LPG Distributorship at Panchkula. She engaged respondents No.8, 12 and 13 as Manager, Clerk and Storekeeper to run the dealership on the asking of respondent No.5, who had offered to help in looking after as well as management of the dealership. In the course of time, respondent Nos. 8, 11 and 12 forged some documents concerning the dealership regarding which petitioner has already filed two civil suits, one at Panchkula and another at Chandigarh. They have been harassing and sexually victimizing the petitioner, her aged father and her brother, who is 70% handicapped. The petitioner has submitted a detailed representation to Superintendent of Police, Mohali and also on one occasion personally met him. But no action has been taken on her complaint.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to look into the representaton moved by the petitioner.

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In view of the above without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to look into the representations submitted by the petitioner and take such action as may be warranted in law.
