RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

This is a petition under Section 438 of the Cr. P.C. For grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 151 dated 21.08.2015 registered under Sections 420/120-B IPC at Police Station, E Division, District Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner and he is ready to join the investigation. He further submits that compromise has been effected in the civil suit.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State oppose the bail application.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to join the investigations and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on *ad interim*

anticipatory bail in FIR No. 151 dated 21.08.2015 to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
