This petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking for quashing of order dated 11.4.2017 passed by the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Bathinda, whereby the detinue, namely Anju Rani was directed to be kept in Nari Niketan, Jalandhar.

Today a photo copy of the order dated 6.10.2017 passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar, has been produced in Court, wherein it is noted that Anju who had been kept in Children Home, Gandhi Vanita Ashram, Jalandhar, has put in appearance before the Court and she has suffered a statement that wants to live with her in-laws. Having attained the age of majority, the detinue was directed to be released from the aforesaid

Ashram and her custody was handed over to her in-laws.

In view of the fact that Anju, the detenue, has attained the age of majority and she has been released from the Children Home, Gandhi Vanita Ashram, Jalandhar, no further orders are called for and this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
