Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0034 dated 20.05.2017 under Sections 452, 324, 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC and Section 326 IPC (which was added later on) registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 5.7.2017 of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and the alleged recovery has been effected and therefore, his custodial interrogation is no more required.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sanjiv Kumar, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the stand taken by learned State counsel that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 5.7.2017 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
