Report dated 22.03.2017 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate (Ist Class) Dhuri has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Gurmeet Singh, Jagjit Singh and Sukhwinder Kaur as well as of complainant Kaur Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR**

Criminal 543 and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.221 dated 29.10.2016 under Sections 323,342,382,384,506,120-B IPC Police Station, Sadar Dhuri District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
