SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The petitioner is facing trial in case First Information Report No.37 dated 18.04.2017 under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code registered against him at Police Station City Dhuri, District Sangrur.

The allegations against the petitioner are that on 17.04.2017 he snatched a polythene bag containing Rs.2000/- from the complainant. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 19.04.2017. As submitted by learned State counsel there is no other criminal case pending against him. The trial is still likely to take some time. Nothing remains to be recovered from the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances and without going into the merits of the case, the petitioner, who is in custody since 19.04.2017 and

there is no plausible ground to detain him further in custody,

is admitted to regular bail during pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
