The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 710, dated 06.11.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506, 447, 307 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of a dispute between neighbours for harvesting of paddy crop. The petitioner, who is stated to have been armed with knife, has caused one blow on the stomach of the injured Sunder. He further contends that the petitioner has been in custody for over 08 months and this is a first FIR, which has ever been registered against him.

Without making any expression on the merits of the case and especially in view of the fact that only one knife blow on the stomach of injured Sunder is attributed to him and he has been in custody for over 08 months, I deem it appropriate to grant him the concession of regular bail.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
