This is an application filed under Order 22 Rule 5 read with Section 151 CPC for bringing on record the legal representatives of appellants No.3 to 7, namely, Darshan Singh, Ujjagar Singh, Kamikkar Singh, Balwant Singh and Pritam Singh.

Learned counsel for the applicants states that during the pendency of the present appeal, appellants No.3 to 7 have died and there is no other legal heir of them except those, whose names have been mentioned in para 2 of this application. No such application has ever been filed by the appellants.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed subject to just exceptions and the legal representatives of deceased-

appellants No.3 to 7 are allowed to be taken on record.

Amended memo of parties is also taken on record.

Prayer in the present application under Section 151 CPC is for placing on record the compromise (Annexure A-1) and to decide the main appeal.

Learned counsel for the applicants states that during pendency of the present appeal, the matter has been compromised between the parties and the compromise deed dated 27.3.2017 is attached as Annexure A-1.
