ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.614 dated 29.11.2016, registered under Sections 323,342 and 506 IPC, at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1) alongwith all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is the outcome of a minor altercation due to misunderstanding between brother and sister.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 23.01.2017 had directed the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Shahabad dated 27.01.2017, has been received, which indicates that the compromise has been recorded without any threat, coercion and undue influence.

The afore-noted FIR is the outcome of a minor altercation due to

misunderstanding between brother and sister. It would be in the interest, if the FIR is

quashed to enable them to live in peace and harmony. In view the mandate of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the case of **Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**, (2014) 6 SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.614, dated 29.11.2016, registered under Sections 323,342 and 506 IPC and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
