SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J (ORAL)

The petitioner was allegedly apprehended for carrying poppy husk/straw weighing 3.20 kilograms. Accordingly to item 110 of the relevant notification relating to 'small and commercial quantity' under the NDPS Act, commercial quantity is 50 kg upwards.

The Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Karnal nevertheless rejected the petitioner's bail application after observing that the recovery was of 'commercial quantity'.

It is fairly conceded on behalf of the State that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

As such, considering the detention undergone by the petitioner till date, he may be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Court below subject to imposition of appropriate terms and conditions, which are also left to the discretion of Ld. Court below.
