This petition is to challenge the FIR No.190 dated 10.03.2005 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station DLF, Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the State submits that out of 27 witnesses 10 witnesses have been examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was inordinate delay in filing the aforesaid FIR. In my opinion, the said point as well as the other points raised in the present petition can variably be taken before the trial Court since the trial is already on.

The present petition is thus disposed of reserving liberty in favour of the petitioner to take all such points as are available in law.

All the points that may be raised are kept open.

Order dated March 26, 2014 made by this Court subjecting the trial subject to this petition stands vacated.
