This is a petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.414 dated 24.08.2016 registered under Sections 380, 420, 427, 467, 468 & 471 IPC at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner and that he is ready to join the investigation.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State as well as the complainant oppose the bail application.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to join the investigations and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail in FIR

No.414 dated 24.08.2016 to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
