The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.169 dated 02.06.2017, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that she had accepted ₹1,00,000/- from the complainant and five others for getting them jobs in the Suvidha Centres. It is further contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated and no other case has ever been registered against her.

This Court vide order dated 24.07.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and on her doing so, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ajaib Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 24.07.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 24.07.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
