ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0037, dated 29.05.2017, under Sections 420, 406, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he along with other accused had duped the complainants on the pretext of sending them abroad. He further contends that the money was not paid to the petitioner and was paid to Gurdeep Singh @ Jassi. He further undertakes that the petitioner shall cooperate with investigation and render all possible assistance to the Investigating Officer including disclosure of the whereabouts of other accused to enable the police to recover the money.

This Court, vide order dated 26.07.2017, had directed

the petitioner to join investigation and on his doing so, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Narotam Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 26.07.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 26.07.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
