The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.54 dated 15.06.2017, under Sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station, Gidderbaha, District Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of the order of this Court dated 28.06.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kishore Chand, states that in terms of the previous order of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from him.

In view of the above, the order dated 28.06.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.
