In view of the fact that the petitioner is admittedly a proclaimed offender, even if his co-accused had been acquitted, still, in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in State of MP vs. Pardeep Sharma, 2014(1) RCR (CrL.) 269, he cannot be admitted to anticipatory bail. However, in the aforesaid circumstances, upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and presenting an application for regular bail, it would be disposed of on the same day by that Court, on its own merits, looking to the facts of the case in detail.

The petition is dismissed.
