

**RAJINDER V/S STATE OF PUNJAB**

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The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.76 dated 04.08.2013 registered under Sections 307, 323, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Bahaw-wala, Tehsil and District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he had instigated his co-accused to fire upon the complainant. Although in the FIR it is stated that the co-accused fired a shot on the leg of the complainant but in the MLR of the complainant only two abrasions have been found on his leg and there is no fire arm injury. He further states that the petitioner is in custody for over 5 months ever since 08.02.2017 and no other case has been registered against them.

In view of the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Fazilka. He shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 439 Cr.P.C.
