The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.456 dated 07.06.2017 under Sections 323/506/285/384/34 IPC read with Section 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is outcome of an altercation between the petitioner and the Manager of a restaurant but no injuries were caused in the occurrence. He further contends that the Sections under which the FIR has been registered, are bailable, except Section 384 IPC which is punishable with imprisonment upto three years. He also contends that offence under the Arms Act is not made out against the petitioner especially when the co-accused Om Prakash is alleged to have fired shots in the air and his weapon, which was

duly licensed, had already been recovered by the police. The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 07.06.2017.

In the light of submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and especially when it is a case of no injury, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. The instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Kulvir is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
