The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 130, dated 02.06.2017, under Sections 15/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR which has been registered on the information furnished by secret informer are that he along with Naib Singh was engaged in selling poppy husk. He further contends that the recovery of 35 kgs of poppy husk was effected from co-accused Naib Singh.

Learned State counsel states that in pursuance to the order of this Court dated 25.07.2017, the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the fact that the recovery was effected from the co-accused and the petitioner has joined the investigation, the order dated 25.07.2017 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
