The instant petition was filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of DDR No.14 dated 0.7.2016 under sections 323, 148, 149 I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Ghuman, Police District Batala.

Since quashing was sought on the basis of compromise, this Court on 25.10.2016 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned on 29.11.2016 or any other date convenient to the court for recording of their statements in support of the compromise.

Placed on record is a report dated 22.12.2016 of the learned J.M.I.C., Batala and a perusal thereof would reveal that inspite of issuance of notice to the parties concerned, neither the complainant nor any of the accused/petitioners came forth for recording of their statements.

Mr. Dheeraj Mahajan, Advocate, who had filed the instant petition also has not come present.

The only inference that can be drawn by this Court is that the compromise alleged to have been effected has not fructified.

Under such circumstances, the present petition seeking quashing of the afore-mentioned DDR on the basis of compromise, is dismissed.
