Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.157 dated 06.06.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Chandi Mandir, District Panchkula.

This Court vide order dated 13.07.2017, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/ Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that during the

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 13.07.2017, petitioners have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Ram Singh, submits that in terms of aforesaid order, petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 13.07.2017 are made absolute.

However, petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
