The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 41, dated 28.03.2017, under Sections 15/18/20/21/22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Lambran, District Jalandhar(Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 100 grams of intoxicant power has been recovered from the petitioner, which as per FSL examination, has been found to be Tramadol, which is not covered under the NDPS Act. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner has been in custody for a period of over 04 months.

Learned Stated counsel upon instructions from ASI Gurmej Singh states that the recovered substance has indeed been found to be Tramadol Hydrochloride.

Heard.

Therefore, as the recovered substance is not covered under the NDPS Act and the petitioner is in custody for over 04 months, I deem it a fit case to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Sandeep Singh @ Bablu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
