The instant petition was preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Seeking quashing of FIR No.177 dated 08.11.2016, under Sections 420/406/465/467/471 IPC, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot on the basis of compromise.

Accordingly, notice of motion was issued on 11.01.2017 and parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 30.01.2017 for recording of their statements in support of the compromise.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused has very fairly stated that the complainant has not supported the compromise and rather got the statements recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate otherwise.

Concededly, a compromise having not been effected, the instant petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis thereof cannot be entertained.

Petition is dismissed.
