ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.119 dated 15.12.2015 under Sections 382/34 IPC (Sections 382/411/324/379-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Daresi, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that with the intervention of respectables, the matter has now been compromised and the parties want to live a peaceful life.

This Court by the order dated 04.07.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court for

recording their statements with regard to the veracity of compromise. The Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, has sent his report dated 28.07.2017, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, statements of the parties were recorded. As per the statements, compromise has been effected without any fear or undue influence.

In view of the law laid down in "**Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab**" 2014 (6) SCC 466, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.119 dated 15.12.2015 under Section 382/34 IPC (Sections 382/411/324/379-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Daresi, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners only.
