None has appeared on behalf of respondents No.5 to 8 despite service. Learned State counsel placed on file reply on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 in the form of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib in which it has been mentioned that police tried to meet the petitioners but they were not found at the address given in the petition. However, the police met the private respondents and father of the petitioner No.1 – Amanpreet Kaur namely Raja Singh (respondent No.5) stated before the police that the petitioners are major and they do not have any grudge against the

marriage of his daughter with petitioner No.2 and further that they are not interfering into their married life and they never threatened the petitioners. Statement of respondent No.5 – Raja Singh has been enclosed.

It being so, no cause of action survives to the petitioners to proceed with the petition and the same is dismissed accordingly.

However, if at any stage, the petitioners apprehend any danger to their lives, they may move representation to SSP Sri Muktsar Sahib who may consider it in accordance with law.
