The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Article 21 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her son and to ensure that respondents No. 8 to 15 should not take the forcible possession of the land situated at Villages Hasanpur, Gagra and Galib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that a complaint was made to SHO, Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana Rural on 21.6.2017 (Annexure P-16) but no action has been taken yet and the petitioner is apprehending threat to her and her son's life.

The present petition is disposed of with the direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ludhiana - respondent No.3, to look into the matter and take required action, if any, on the complaint dated 21.6.2017 (Annexure P-16) expeditiously.
