Heard learned counsel for the rival parties. The petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.180 dated 12.6.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325, 302, 307, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar District Panipat. This Court had ordered recording of evidence of material witnesses. Accordingly, the material witnesses have been examined and cross examined. I have perused their depositions. In so far as the petitioner is concerned, the evidence against him is that he had given a blow by means of a wooden stick (binda) on the back of the complainant. In that view of the matter, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail.

Hence, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall not enter District Panipat save and except on the date of hearing.
