The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.225 dated 15.11.2005 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This Court has passed order dated 03.07.2017 vide which the parties are referred to mediation centre and it is ordered that no coercive means shall be adopted against the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mediation has failed. However he further submits that the parties have compromised the matter. A copy of the compromise is placed on record by the counsel for the petitioner, which is taken on record and marked as Mark X.

The petitioner has today paid an amount of ₹4,00,000/- in cash to the complainants as per the compromise.

Both the complainants have accepted the amount as well as admitted the fact of the compromise between the parties and further submitted that they have no grievance against the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the matter has since been compromised and the complainant have no grievance remain against the petitioner, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

In the result, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on *ad-interim* anticipatory bail in FIR No.225 dated 15.11.2015 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur, on furnishing of bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
