Allegations against the petitioner Monu alias Raman in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in case FIR No.325 dated 04.05.2017 registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, are that on 04.05.2017 from the conscious possession of the petitioner, 25 grams of Heroin was recovered from the right pocket of the jeans worn by him leading to his arrest.

Contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner are that only non-commercial quantity of contraband has been recovered from the petitioner and that he is in custody since 04.05.2017.

Though the factual scenario could not be displaced by learned State counsel who certainly has tried to oppose grant of relief to the petitioner.

Appreciating the submissions of the two sides, keeping in view that only non-commercial quantity of contraband has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and petitioner is behind bar since long time and culpability, if any, shall be determined at the time of trial which is not likely to conclude in near future, further detention of the petitioner in the present case is unwarranted. Accordingly, he is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
