Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.130 dated 24.10.2016, under Sections 302, 341, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur. This Court had made an order dated 04.07.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Pursuant to the order made by learned trial Court, under Section 193 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioners were summoned. This Court had made an interim order dated 04.07.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the complainant fervently states to this

Court that the petitioners having threatening the witnesses.

Looking to the fact that the petitioners were asked to appear before the trial Court as accused at a later stage, I am inclined to confirm *ad interim* order dated 04.07.2017. However, petitioners are directed not to tamper with the prosecution witnesses or threatening the victim or any other person. If it is found that the petitioners indulge in such activities, liberty is reserved in favour of the concerned police officer to apply for revocation of this order granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

In that view of the matter, interim order dated 04.07.2017 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. Petitioners are directed not to tamper with the prosecution witnesses or threatening the victim or any other person. If it is found that the petitioners indulge in such activities, liberty is reserved in favour of the concerned police officer to apply for revocation of this order granting anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
