The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.79 dated 03.08.2015 registered under Section 22/61/85 NDPS Act at Police Station Division No.8, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This Court had granted *ad interim* bail to the petitioner vide order dated 04.07.2017, since the challan was not filed when the petition was filed.

Now learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official, makes statement that the challan has been filed before the trial Court.

In my opinion, since the challan has been filed, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court and if so advised

may file petition for regular bail. The trial Court, without influencing from the order of this Court, shall decide the petition for regular bail on its own merits in accordance with law.

Interim order dated 04.07.2017 passed by this Court granting interim bail to the petitioner, shall continue till 19.08.2017 and shall come to end automatically thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
