ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0016 dated 25.04.2017 under sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 285, 307, 302 IPC and sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station GRP Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner-Amritpal Singh @ Gosha has been falsely implicated in the case and he has not been named in the FIR. He further contends that although initially a case was registered under section 302 IPC but the police has filed challan only under section 304 IPC on 19.07.2017 along with afore-noted sections.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature. The FIR has been registered at the behest of a Constable of Railway Police stating therein that several persons were quarreling with each other and they were giving beating to one person. They had also fired a shot with fire arm. He has also stated that these persons were 8-9 in number and were calling each other by name of Deepa, Sardul, Gadrana, Jagga, Gaggu, Gadrana and Labby.

Later Deepa and Labby were arrested and they had disclosed that the petitioner was one of the persons who were a part of their group at the place of occurrence.

In view of the aforementioned allegations which are serious in nature and without commenting upon the merits of the case, I do not deem it a fit case to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the application for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
