In FIR No.123 dated 01.07.2015, under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 (for short 'NDPC Act'), registered at Police Station Division No.1, Jalandhar, the petitioner seeks regular bail. The petitioner was arrested and is in jail.

Learned State counsel submits that there is no other offence against the petitioner under the NDPS Act. Two prosecution witnesses have been examined and 6 witnesses are to be yet examined, those are official witnesses.

In that view of the matter, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned. Petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence, threaten or exercise any influence on the prosecution witnesses.
