ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.135 dated 08.11.2007, under Sections 307/452/323/324/506/326/148/149 of the IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bilga, Police District Jalandhar Rural, Punjab (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise, which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is an offshoot of a dispute between real brothers, which has now been resolved with the intervention of respectables. He further contends that injuries are simple in nature.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 28.07.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to

this Court. The report of JMIC, Phillaur, District Jalandhar dated 02.08.2017 has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

The FIR is an offshoot of a dispute between real brothers which has now been resolved with the intervention of respectables. The injuries are stated to be simple in nature.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466*, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.135 dated 08.11.2007, under Sections 307/452/323/324/506/326/148/149 of the IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bilga, Police District Jalandhar Rural, Punjab and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
