Present petition has been filed alleging that the compromise (Annexure P-4) reached between the parties stands breached by respondent No.2-Mohit Aggarwal. Whereas, learned counsel for respondent No.2 has circulated a copy of the affidavit (same is taken on record as Mark 'A') and states that he stands by the compromise and shall act by the understanding reached between the parties. The learned State counsel also informs that there is no allegation of misusing of the concession of bail. Though, a complaint has been received with regard to some withdrawal made by the petitioner, however, there is no complaint made by the present petitioner with regard to any threat or coercion to the petitioner. Reply on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed in the Court, same is taken on record.

In view of the submission made, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
