Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 12.7.2015, under Sections 302, 323 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other co-accused inconnivance with each other have given beatings to Lachhman Singh and then all the accused persons and Bagga Singh with intention to kill poured petrol on Darbara Singh. Darbara Singh has died.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh states that in the case in hand the trial in the case is almost on the

verge of completion. All the prosecution witnesses except one witness i.e. the investigating officer have been examined. Even the prosecution witness i.e. the investigating officer is likely to be examined tomorrow i.e. 18.7.2017.

In view of the advanced stage of the trial, no case for grant of bail is made out.

Dismissed.
