The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.81 dated 20.12.2016 under Sections 307/452/427/323/324/148/149 registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the incident is outcome of road rage and the petitioners also received injuries in the said incident as a result of which they have also lodged cross DDR. He further contends that the petitioners are in custody for over five months and the matter has now been compromised between the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the matter has been amicably resolved and they have preferred

petitions bearing CRM No.M-21892 of 2017 and CRM No.M-21896 of 2017 for quashing the above said FIR and DDR, on the basis of compromise, which are listed on 20.07.2017.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The incident is stated to have taken place due to sudden altercation between the parties, who have now compromised the matter. The petitioners are stated to be in custody for over five months.

In view of the aforementioned facts and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioners Sukhpreet Singh @ Sukha and Sonu are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
