The petitioner is seeking quashing of FIR No.91 dated 10.06.2017, under Sections 452, 336, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Division C, District Police Commissioner, Shri Amritsar Sahib (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of no injury and with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised.

This Court by the order dated 06.07.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of JMIC, Amritsar, dated 28.07.2017 has been received, wherein it is

stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded which indicates that the compromise is genuine, without any coercion or undue influence.

It is stated to be a case of no injury and with the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised.

In view of the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, no useful purpose will be served by continuing the criminal proceedings. Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No.91 dated 10.06.2017, under Sections 452, 336, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Division C, District Police Commissioner, Shri Amritsar Sahib (Annexure P-1) and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
