Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh, Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran states that the petitioners are not required to be arrested by police of said police station and as a matter of fact cancellation report is being prepared to be filed in the Court. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, at any stage, the petitioners are required to be arrested, then the police of Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran would give seven days prior notice to them.

Heard.

It being so no cause of action survives to the petitioners.

The petition stands dismissed. However, as per statement of learned State counsel, in case, the petitioners are required to be arrested in this case, at any stage of investigation, then the police of Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran would give seven days prior notice to them.
