The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.40 dated 05.06.2017, under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from her.

In response to the previous order, Rupinder Kaur, daughter of the complainant has come present in the court and met her mother.

Learned DAG Punjab for the respondent-State, on instructions from Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 06.07.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
