Petitioners seek grant of regular bail in FIR No.28 dated 28.02.2017, under Sections 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 Section 341 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

I have perused the FIR and seen the impugned order passed by the learned trial Court. There is direct recovery from the possession of both the petitioners that includes intoxicant tablets and weapons. The allegations against the petitioners are of serious nature. In that view of the matter, relief of grant of regular bail to the petitioners cannot be granted.
