Petitioner-Kanwardeep Singh has filed this 2nd petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in cross-case registered vide DDR No.11 dated 17.07.2015, registered under Sections 307, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Jhabhal, in FIR No.73 dated 16.07.2015, registered at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that earlier, the petitioner filed petition for anticipatory bail which was got withdrawn by learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for sometime, when this court was not inclined to grant him bail. In the present case, the petitioner has already been declared

proclaimed offender and instead of appearing before the police and joining the investigation, the petitioner has again filed this second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that the petitioner has already been declared proclaimed offender and has avoided the process of law, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
