This order will dispose of four petitions bearing CWP Nos. 2830, 2837, 2838 and 2839 of 2004.

The petitioners have challenged the award dated 11.6.2002 of the Land Acquisition Tribunal, (Improvement Trust), Bathinda, assessing the compensation for the acquired land and seeking further enhancement of compensation.

The writ petition was admitted on 20.2.2004, to be listed along with CWP No. 13300 of 2003.

Registry has placed on file the order passed in the aforesaid writ petition bearing No. 13300 of 2003. The same was dismissed on January 28, 2014 by passing the following order:

“Learned counsel for the parties are ad-idem that the award under challenge passed by the Tribunal constituted under the Town Improvement Trust Act, 1922, has been upheld by a Division Bench of this Court vide order dated 03.03.2009 passed in CWP No. 15326 of 2002 (Bhikam Singh and another Veresus The District Judge, Bathinda and others) and other

connected cases.

This writ petition is accordingly dismissed for the reasons assigned in the order dated 03.03.2009 passed in Bhikam Singh and another's case (supra).”

A perusal of the aforesaid order shows that the award of the Tribunal has already been upheld and prima-facie nothing survive in the present petitions. As none has appeared in the present petitions, the same are dismissed for non-prosecution.
