ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.12 dated 23.01.2017, under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Nandgarh, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that although he is alleged to have accepted money from the complainant for transfer of shares but the shares were transferred to third person instead of the complainant. Learned counsel further contends that the petitioner did not transfer the shares to third person and no money was accepted from the complainant and without prejudice to its right, the petitioner is willing to return amount of Rs.3,33,300/- to the complainant, which is stated to have been paid through cheque to the complainant. Learned counsel also contends that an amount of Rs.3,33,300/- has been deposited in the account of the complainant on 10.10.2017.

This Court, by the order dated 01.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mehnga Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, the order dated 01.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
